To become a monthly senior client: You must be age 60 or older and you must make an appointment to meet with a member of the Pastor's Pantry team at the pantry warehouse located on 307 North State Street in Lexington.

Proof of income (Social Security Statement or Bank Statement)	Health insurance
 Picture ID for all members in the home (16 or older) 	Life insurance
 Proof you have applied for food stamps or FS card 	Utilities: Gas/Electric/Oil/Water
Rent or house payment	 Current loan(s)
Home Insurance	Credit card debt
Car payment	 Cable Television/Internet/Phone
Medication / Medical Bills	Car insurance
